Artists DO NOT NEED to have an active membership with the Red Rock Pastel Society of Nevada to be eligible to enter the show, but it is always encouraged.

ENTRY DEADLINE: The entry form and the digital images of your work to be submitted as well as the payment of the entry fee to be validated on <u>ShowSubmit.com</u> before May 5th, 2022.

ELIGIBLE WORK: Please read carefully to make sure that your work meets the following entry requirements:

This is **a themed show**. The theme is RED and your own artistic interpretation of it.

• Your works must be done with dry pastel; the top layer must consist of at least 80% of dry pastel. No oil pastels can be used.

• Only two-dimensional works are permissible. Pastel mosaic, sculpture, and digital pastel works are not eligible.

 \cdot The work must be original, not copied from other artists or from any other published material. Works done from photographs made by someone other than the artist are not eligible.

• Please withhold from entering any work that has been awarded major awards (Best in Show, I, 2, 3 places) in any other online or live shows.

• All artwork must be originally drawn and not created on top of a photo or a print.

• All works must have been created within the last two years.

• Paintings of nudes will be considered for acceptance.

• Not for Sale works (NFS) will NOT be accepted

• Works done under supervision (such as in a workshop or class) are not eligible. Works done during or based on images from the unguided group online sessions are not eligible.

• Work exhibited in 2019-2021 RRPSNV Member Juried Exhibitions is not eligible.

Works accepted to 2022 Red Rock online exhibition are eligible to enter if it reflects the theme of the show, RED.

Failure to meet any of the requirements will result in your work not being juried. No substitutions are allowed.

ENTRY FEE:

For Non Members: \$25.00 for the first image and \$10.00 for each additional image.

For Members: \$15 and \$10.00 for each additional image.

For Platinum Members: \$5 and \$5.00 for each additional image.

Up to 5 images may be submitted by an individual artist. Entry fees are not refundable and must be paid by the entry deadline.

ONLINE ENTRY: Entry is online only. Go to <u>www.ShowSubmit.com</u>, create your log in and select Red Rock Pastel Society of Nevada 2022 Live National Show.

Please make sure you are entering the correct show. Follow the directions for entry. You do not need to have a PayPal account to pay the entry fee online, just a valid credit card.

Please follow these instructions carefully regarding the preparation of your images:

- Only jpeg (or jpg) image files will be accepted.
- Save your files with a resolution of 300 dpi.
- Then resize Required image size is at least 1500 pixels on the longest side.
- Rename your image files by using your last name, underscore, first initial, underscore, Title
- Please remove all spaces and special characters in the version of the title that you use, and abbreviate if lengthy. For example: Jane Doe's painting My Daughter's Scarf becomes Doe_J_MyDaughtersScarf.jpg

ACCEPTANCE: Up to 5 entries may be submitted from an individual artist. Please add office@showsubmit.com to your safe sender's list to ensure email delivery. The amount of the accepted images by the artist may vary at jurors' discretion.

Beginning June 15th, all accepted works will be displayed on the RRPSNV website, 2022, and in-person at the Show Gallery. Even though the notification of accepted works will go out on May 10th, we kindly ask you to refrain from posting images of your accepted painting until the show is open.

All accepted works will be also displayed on the Red Rock Pastel of Nevada website, promoted on Red Rock Social Media, and included in the printed exhibition catalog.

ENTRY PROCEDURES FOR ARTISTS OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES:

Use the same entry procedures as listed above.

FRAMING OF ARTWORK: All artwork needs to be framed, framed size needs to be specified in the submission.

ARTWORK DELIVERY: See your acceptance letter.

SALES: Not for Sale works (NFS) will NOT be accepted. All sales will be handled by the gallery. The details of the procedure will be provided to artists upon acceptance to the show.

The parts of the prospectus might change without notifying the entrant. By submitting your work to the Red Rock Show you give the RR permission to use the images for promotional purposes.
